

This was a 214% increase








DEMOGRAPHICS OF ARLANDRIA


- Nestled between Arlington County and City of Alexandria

ALEXANDRIA'S STRATEGIC RESPONSE

- Create an up to date moped registration program for Officers to access on their mobile computers
- Research and distribute a proper locking device for moped owners
- Identify hot spots and increase patrol officer presence





ALEXANDRIA'S STRATEGIC RESPONSE

- Mopeds registered should be identified quickly as being registered through the Police Department. Making it an undesirable target for would-be criminals
- The police would partner with apartment management companies in the location that was hit hardest by thefts
